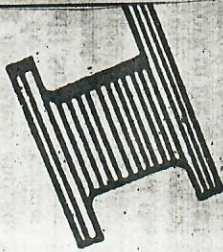


## The Historical Corner

Q. What is the second oldest house in Lycoming County?

A. The eleven room "House of Many Stairs" in Pennsdale is the second oldest house in Lycoming County. It was built about 1784 by Samuel Wallis but was not used by him. In 1790 it became the Bulls Head Tavern. Subsequent years saw it used for the underground railway. The house is unique in that every one of its rooms is on a different level with stairs between each one.
